

The best place to put all of these items are in cabinets, ovens, utility rooms and garage!

- *Remove cars from driveways
 - *Remove anything on the front door of the house and anything that is cluttered in the entry way.
 - *Remove soaps, shampoos, (especially in showers!) toothbrushes, dishes, sponges, paper towel holders, dishes any clutter in kitchens and bathrooms. Appliances in kitchens are fine.
 - *Remove bath mats, rugs from both bathrooms, foyers and kitchens as they are eye sores even if they look nice
 - *Remove magnets off of refrigerators and items on top of refrigerators.
 - *Remove trash cans from all rooms
 - *Remove pet bowls and any pet toys, cages, beds, including pets. *Remove large pictures of people on walls or tables unless they are mounted. Small picture frames are fine as they are barely seen.
 - *Remove remote controls
 - *Fluff up pillows or remove them if they stand out on couches and chairs
 - *Kids rooms are usually cluttered, do the best to get rid of large items like stuffed animals.
 - *Remove garden hoses and security signs in yards.
 - *Remove pool cleaners in lanais (skimmers)
 - *Open all blinds, curtains and turn on all lights in all rooms including ceiling and table lamps. And outdoor lights as well.
